The Challengers Facilitator will live on-site at Camp Banting, hosted by the Bonnenfant Y Outdoor Centre in Dunrobin, Ontario from Aug 4-18th. This position will work with the Leadership Director, program team and medical team. They will facilitate leadership programs to 16-17 year old youth. This means creating and implementing the leadership program; where participants will develop communication skills, trust- and respect-building skills, time management skills and general leadership skills. The role also entails supervising participants during down time and ensuring the physical and emotional safety of campers on site.
